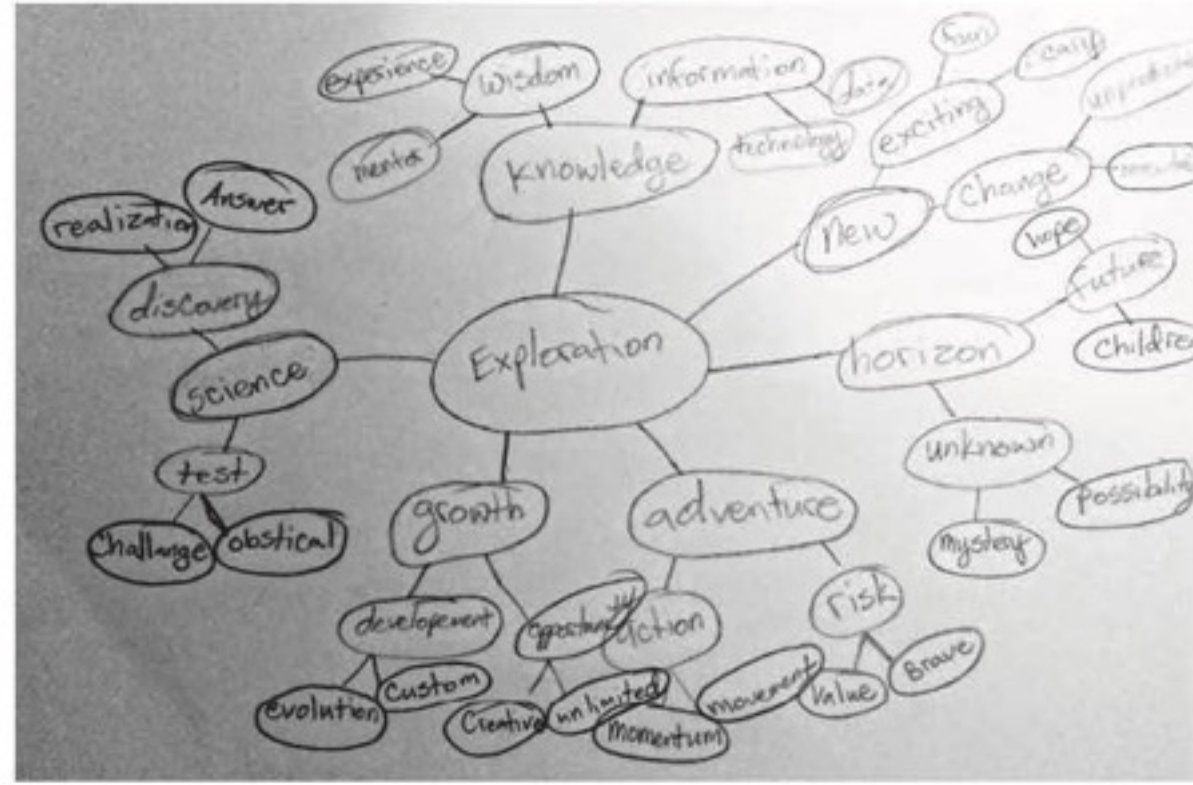

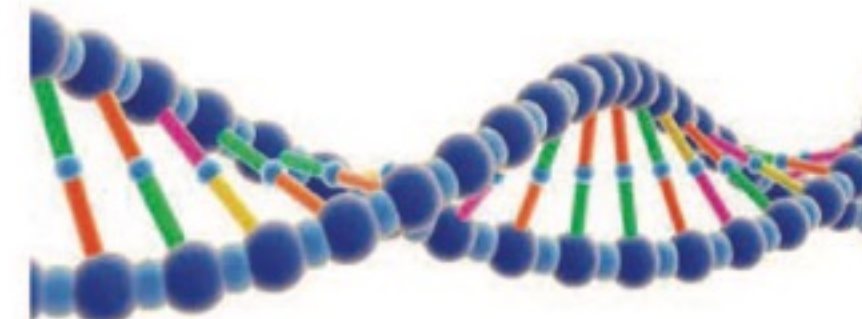
1. The systematic study of the nature and behaviour of the material and physical universe, based on observation, experiment, and measurement, and the formulation of laws to describe these facts in general terms

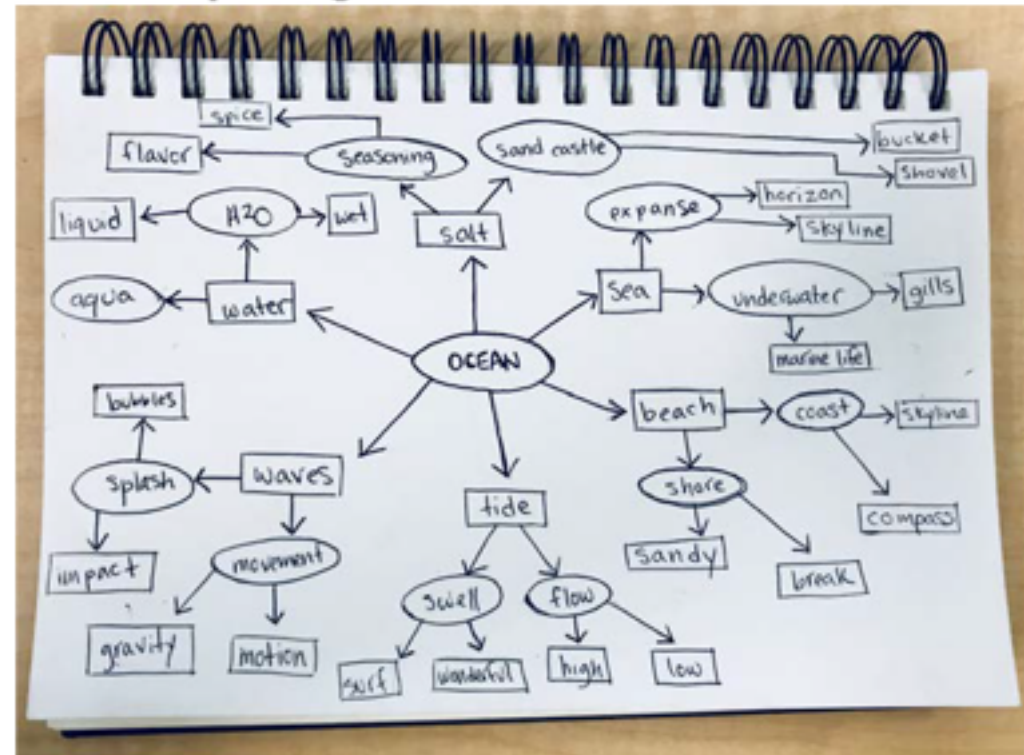

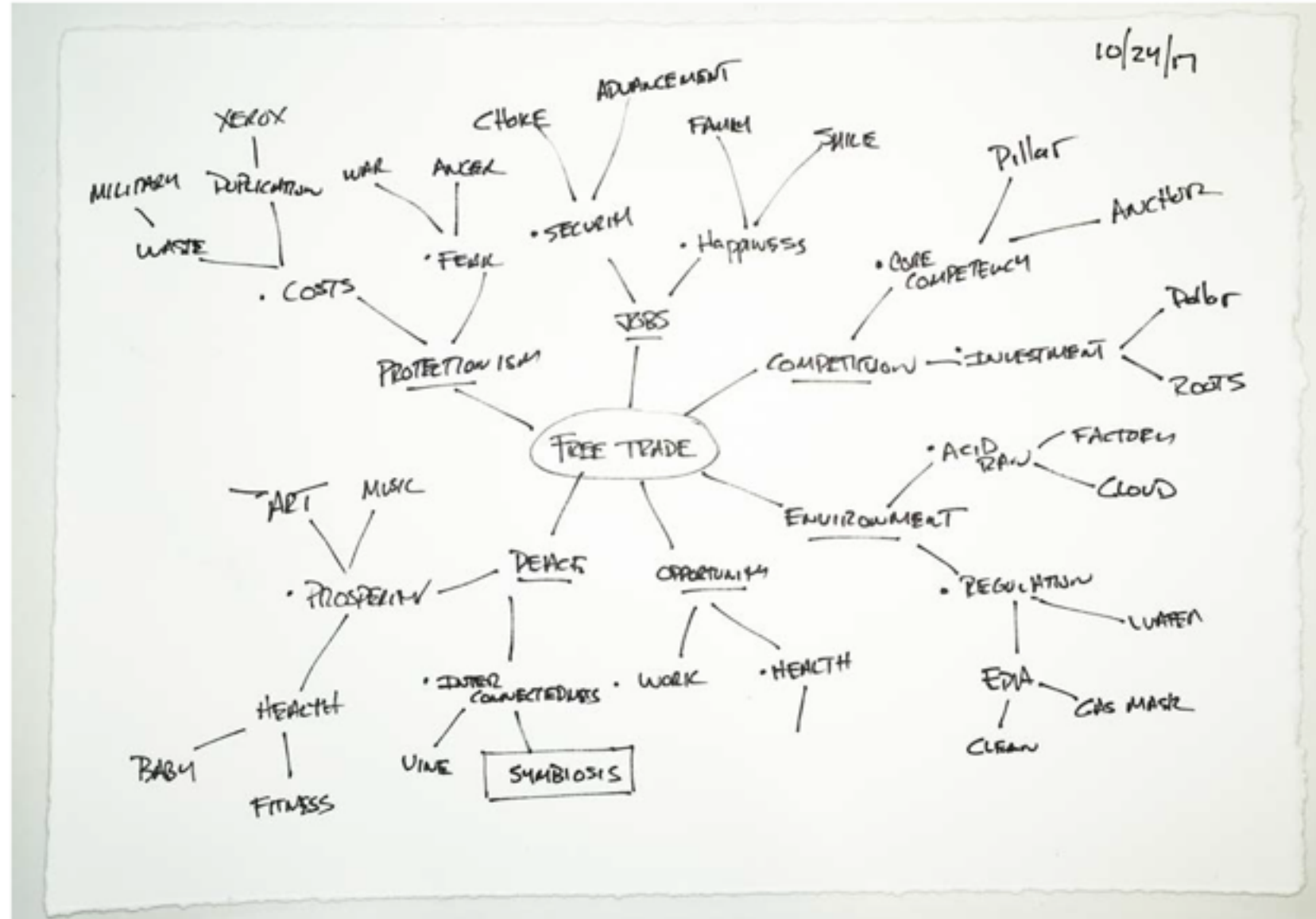

late 19th century: modern Latin, from Greek *symbiōsis* 'a living together,' from *symbioun* 'live together,' from *symbios* 'companion.'

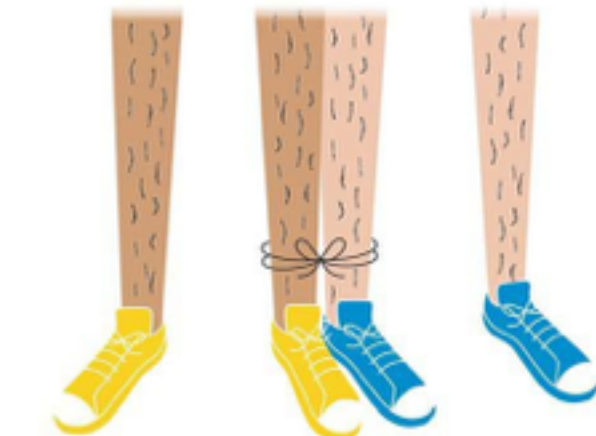

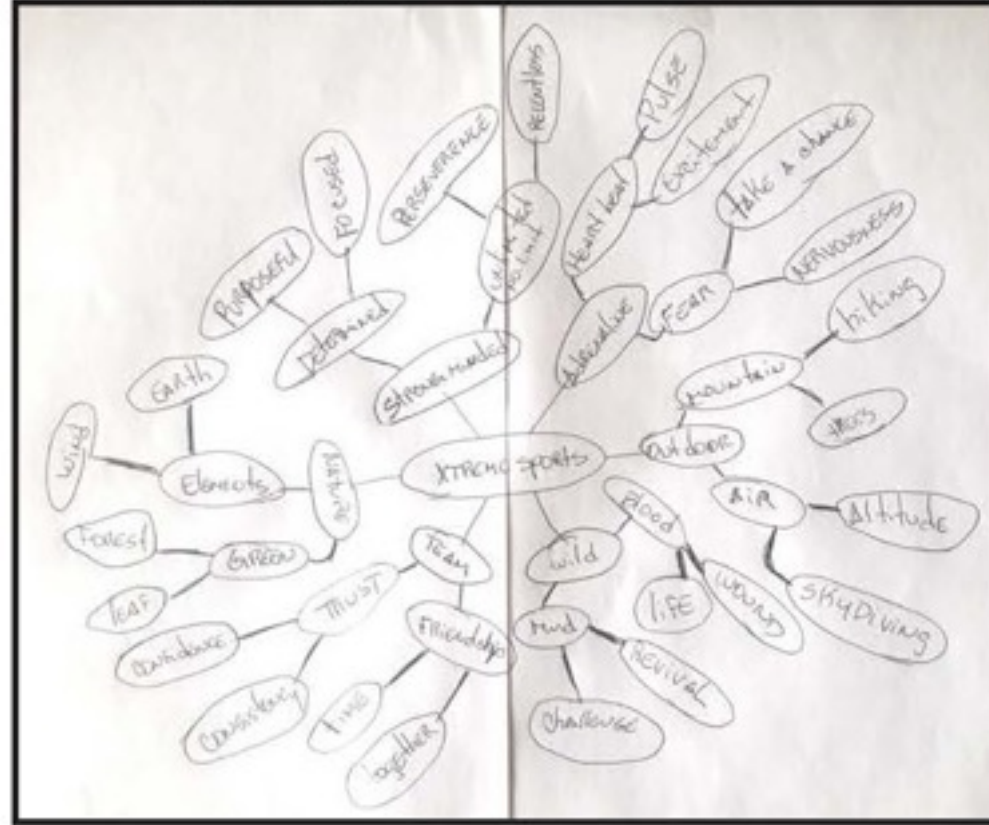

Extreme Sports

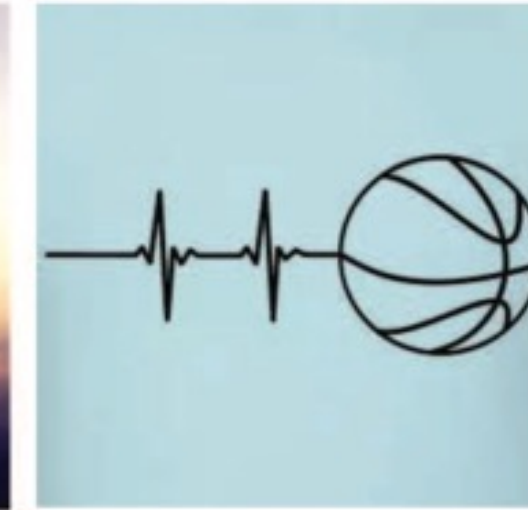
### Definitions (denotation):

- Extreme sports are recreational activities perceived as involving a high degree of risk. These activities often involve speed, height, a high level of physical exertion, and highly specialized gear
